### **EYFS News**

Science work has continued this week, learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. The children have enjoyed using the familiar story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and have produced some fantastic writing to re-tell the story. We have been learning about suffixes in phonics lessons- the different 'endings' words can have and how to spell and say them - e.g. jump, jumpING, jumpED.
