Next week we will be on week 2 of our spring/summer menu.

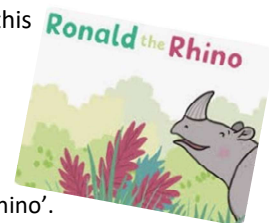
Merits
