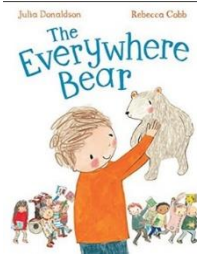
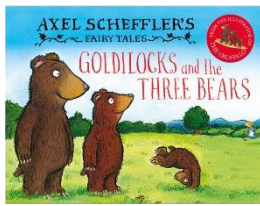




Key Knowledge and Skills
Year 1 Autumn 2

This half term in year 1, we will be reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Everywhere Bear by Julia Donaldson and The Three Musketeers. We will be using these texts to inspire our own writing.

<p>Science</p> <p>We will be learning to observe changes in the four seasons. We will be learning how to observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.</p> <p>We will be sorting pictures that describe each season and matching them correctly. We will be heading outside to look for signs of Autumn in our school environment.</p> <p>We will be collecting data to describe the weather including collecting temperature readings and using a wind sock to measure the wind.
