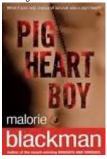
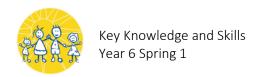


This half term in year 6, we will be exploring key ideas in 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman and using the text to inspire our own writing.
