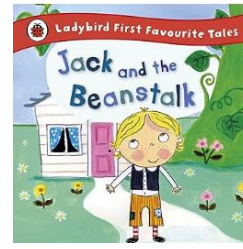
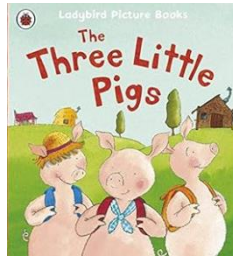
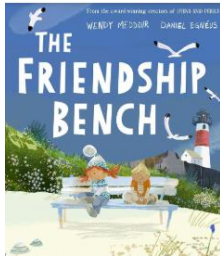




Key Knowledge and Skills
